Evart High School has been improving its SAT preparation program for the past several years. Prior to the first mandated school closure due to the COVID pandemic, EHS created and implemented an intensive SAT preparation program that included fall pre-testing, a minimum of ten hours of targeted individualized instruction and opportunities for students to receive additional individualized supports so that they would perform on the spring state assessment to the highest of their potential.

Although the pandemic has subdued these efforts for the past two school years, EHS students of the 2021-2022 school year will once again have access to the regimen of SAT preparation that we believe will set our students up for success. To date, our ninth through eleventh grade students have already taken two practice tests from the SAT suite, have had more than five hours of direct instruction on SAT preparation, and are slated to receive a minimum of eight more hours of small group targeted instruction prior to the April test.
